

Abstract Submission Guidelines

Please use Time New Roman, 12 pt, with bold formatting when specified.

The deadline for abstract submission (oral or poster presentation) is **Monday 13 April 2026**. Abstract must be submitted in PDF Format.

Oral Presentation (PhD candidates)

Oral presentations are intended for PhD candidates near the completion of their thesis to present mature projects. The total duration of your presentation is 10 minutes (6–7 minutes talk, 3–4 minutes Q&A). Please strictly respect the allocated time and ensure that sufficient time is left for questions. The Best Oral Presentation Award will be based on the quality of the presentation and response to questions.

Poster Presentation (PhD candidates)

Poster presentations are recommended for early to mid-stage PhD candidates to present their research and progress. Posters should be prepared in A0 format (portrait) and fit within the allocated panel dimensions (1.80 m × 1.20 m). During the poster session, presenters should be prepared to deliver a 2-minute flash talk and answer questions from attendees. The Best Poster Presentation Award will be based on the quality of the flash talk.

Poster Presentation (ULB Technology Platform)

Posters should be prepared in A0 format (portrait) and fit within the allocated panel dimensions (1.80 m × 1.20 m). Technology Platform posters do not require abstract submission and are not included in the abstract selection process. However, registration for poster presentation is mandatory. Please indicate your participation in the registration form by selecting « Poster (other) ».
